Peguis Multiplex Arena Project

The Peguis First Nation along with the Peguis Arena Committee has engaged Ayshkum Engineering to help design a multi use arena facility for the Peguis First Nation. The goal of the project is to have a facility for all Peguis Hockey Programs. The facility will also be utilized year round by the community for a variety of purposes.

The multiplex will be located on the Peguis First Nation directly across PTH 224 from the old Peguis Central School now known as the Peguis Rec Center.

Rationale

The design of the multi use arena can facilitate a variety of events such as:
All minor hockey league and playoff games, MAHA play downs, hosting major events for example: Western Canadian JR B Championship, winter carnivals, treaty events, concerts and rental of the facility for other events.

The arena is designed with a four lane track around the seating area on the main concourse. Also a fitness room underneath the south end concourse area is planned. This facility will benefit Peguis as a hub of social activity and will promote community involvement and participation.
